Member doings: The Schedule of tasks is as above and most Society members already know of the details of set-up. The expanded day by day schedule is as follows:

1. By Sunday or Monday before, have plants ready and if desired, registered for judging by listing them and e-mailing the lists to Joanna Eckstrom JKEckstrom@comcast.net A form to fill out for judging is on the CAIOS.org website and it can be copied and e-mailed to Joanna. A Sample will be in the Newsletter. Preregistration helps the judging entry process. Classification list at Show and on line.
2. Work crew to meet at 8:30 AM at the CAIOS Lockup(Storage Pros on E. Falmouth Highway) and load supplies and schlep to the Resort, then set up basic venue. Assemble light sets and set them out for exhibits and vendors.
3. Bring plants to the Resort (Next to Paddocks Restaurant at the Hyannis West End Rotary) on Thursday morning to by 3 PM for primping and labeling. Be sure to bring a list of your plants and keep a copy for yourself so as to get them back after the Show. Put YOUR name and plant name on tape on the side of the pot. Remove bugs, dead sheathing on bulbs, protect from frost with light plastic cover. All blooming plants should be brought and even if few flowered, can be clustered for nice effect.
4. All assigned help will prep plants and create display and set up lights as needed. Also, greet outside exhibitors and help them carry in, they appreciate it!
5. Friday Morning - light breakfast for clerks & Judges and Meet at 8:30 AM for Ribbon Judging. Lunch for clerks and Judges. American O. S. Judging in afternoon, members welcome to listen.
6. Banquet - come enjoy and be prepared to buy plants, bring your money and feed your habit while keeping vendors happy. See past newsletters for the Buffet Menu. *(For last minute BANQUET QUESTIONS, CALL JOYCE KODIS -- (508) 758-2888)*
7. Sat. & Sun. - Show – Enjoy, help talk to guests, man the member & raffle tables etc.
8. At breakdown, arrange to retrieve your own plants or store with friends.

CAIOS fills in Display #, Exhibitor #, Then You fill out the info in the header and the plant names and class if you can by looking up in the Classification list on the website. Or just provide the list to the folks at the judging entry computers. Be sure to label *all* your pages with CAIOS and your name. A full sheet is included with paper copies of the Newsletter.
